# STARTING AND ENDING THE DAY

## Punctuality

Thank you for ensuring that your child arrives at school by 8:55.

# UNIFORM

# REWARDS AND CONSEQUENCES

## Dojos

Children are able to earn dojos both in class and in the playground. When children in Year 4 reach 1000 as a class, they are able to select their own dojo character. 1000 whole class dojos entitles the class to a preselected reward. Children must work together and support one another in order to get their whole class reward.

## School behaviour System

Dojos can be lost if children move down the behaviour system. Children are given a verbal warning which serves as a reminder before any dojos are lost.
